Some of the estate village allotments survive but otherwise much of the 'modern' development has happened, though the 21st century treescape has yet to grow. On the near-side of the High Street / Avenue are the 'Bovril' Cottages in Old Way (1965) and what will grow as the Spinney to the rear of them; the new Village Hall replacing 7&8 Bletsoe, the 'rounding-off' development of Bennett's Close, and a couple of large extensions to historic buildings. On the far side, 39-44 Bletsoe has been replaced by St Mary's Close and Captain's Close; there is a string of new developments running down left from the house occupied by the Green family to the site of the former Parish Clerk's Cottage. Notice the absence of cars ...
