


Bletsoe Castle and Farm, 1930s

Bletsoe Castle below farm buildings; parish church to their right (west). Below Bletsoe Castle the earthworks for the 15th and 16th century formal gardens; to left of them corrugated lines of medieval ridge-and-furrow ploughing that would be destroyed in war-time and austerity conversion of pasture to arable.
