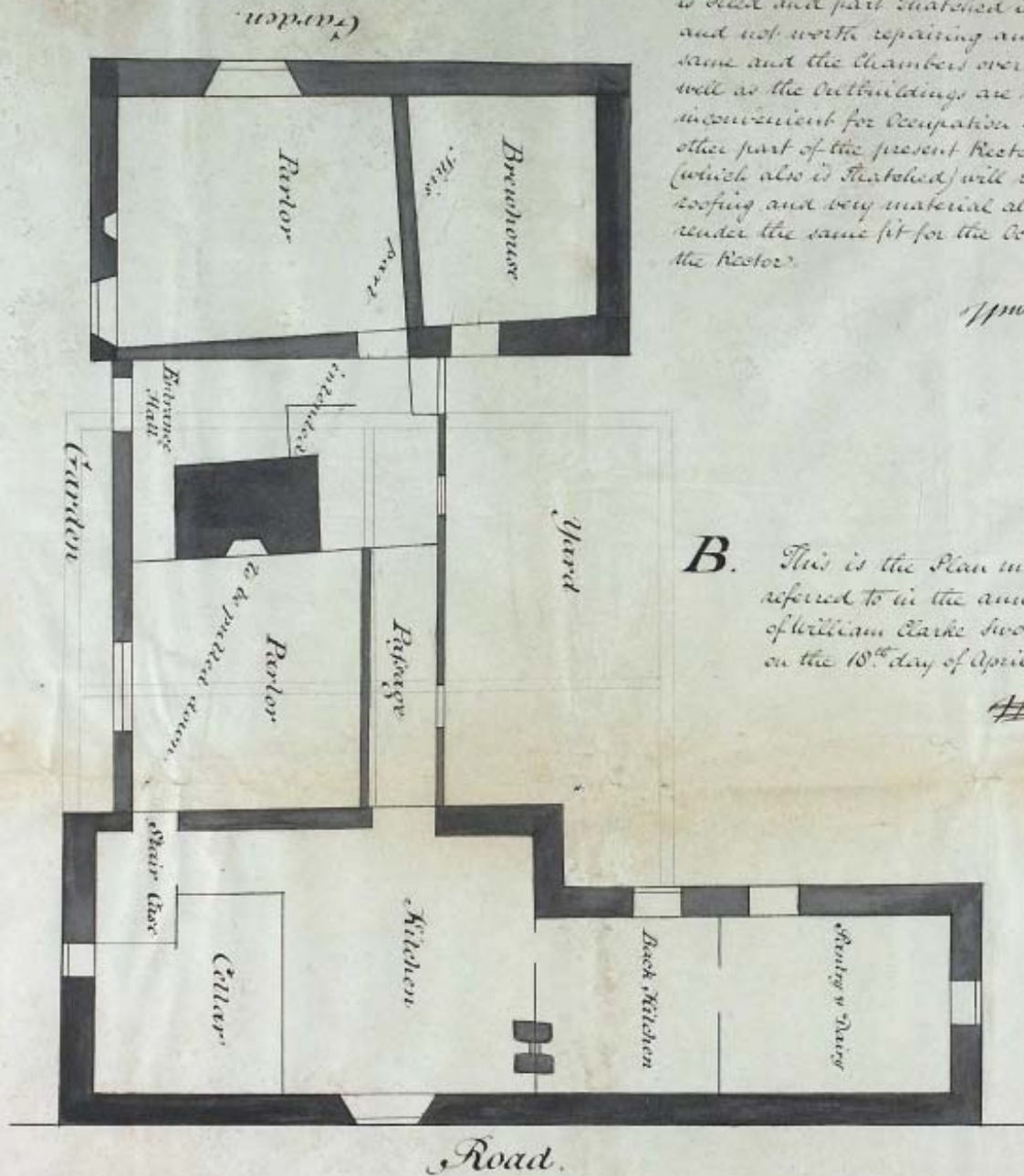


I do hereby certify that the state of that part of the Rectory House which is intended to be pulled down part of which is tiled and part thatched is very old and not worth repairing and that the same and the chambers over the same as well as the outbuildings are very inconvenient for occupation and that the other part of the present Rectory House (which also is thatched) will require new roofing and very material alteration to render the same fit for the occupation of the Rector.
