of our lady saint mary of Abletresha about whiche I bequeeth in the name of my mortuary at the
custome requyte I will and bequeeth in the day of my buriall or as shortly after as may be conu-
niently done about my funeral expenses con hundred and xxij I bequeeth unto the fficers of Bedford
shyre I geve and bequeeth unto Oliver my sonne all such landes tenementes meadowes leysures pastures
with all thier appurtenances belonging to, unto the which I have in the towne of Charnocke. Milton and
Kynston within the shire of Bedford shyre I will that the said Oliver my sonne have of other goodes mountable
unto the sum of xxli I geve and bequeeth unto Alexander my sonne landes and pastures lying about
Bedford with thier appurtenances unto the sum of fyve my I geve and bequeeth unto the forsaide
Alexander my sonne of other goodes mountable unto the sum of twenty poundes I will that all my
household family shall have mete and drink and all such complete wages as they have had of me for
the tyme and space of con yere complete immediately after my decesse the residue of all other my goodes
abone not bequest my debts well and truly paid my funeral expenses had and doon and this my
present testament and last will fulfilled I geve and bequeeth to the discretions of John Saint John Sir
William Gascoyne knight Oliver Saint John and Alexander Saint John my sonnes whom I make my
true and faithfull exequutors that they shal do for the helth of my soule and all xpen soules as it shall
seme them best and every con of them to have for thier busynesse and labour fyve poundes a yere and
my lord moresy shal be my Executor of this my last will and he shal have for his labour xliij s
