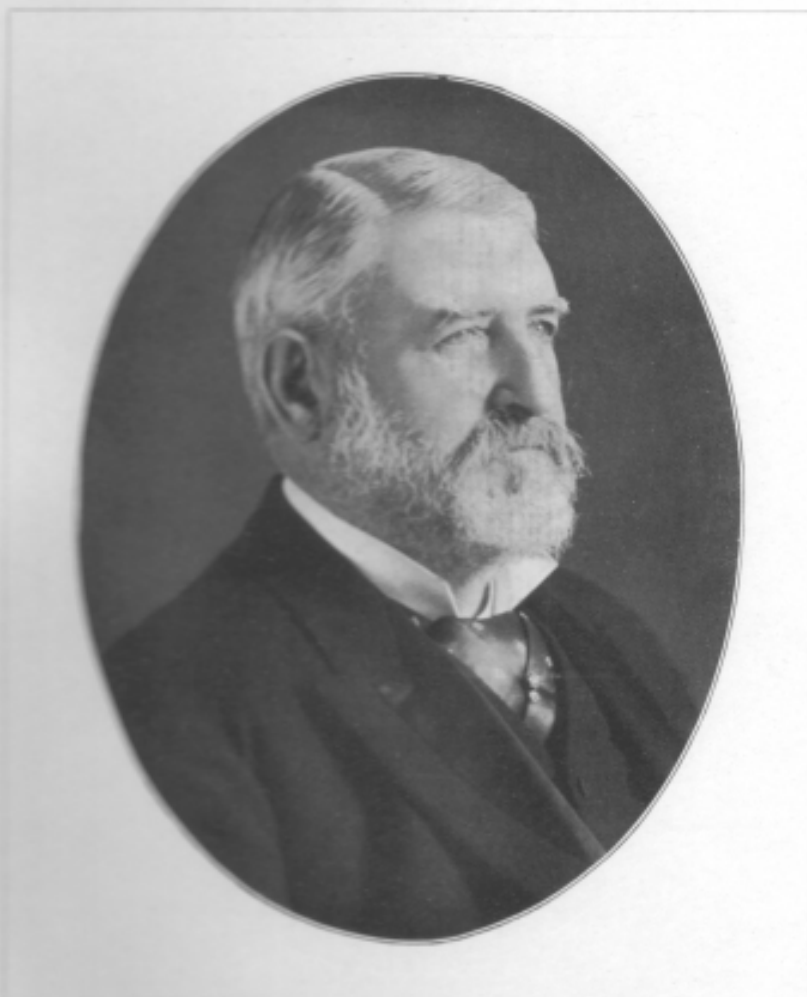


THE RIGHT HON. LORD ST. JOHN, J.P.,

LORD LIEUTENANT OF BEDFORDSHIRE.



THE RIGHT HON. LORD ST. JOHN, 16TH BARON, created 1558 (BEAUCHAMP MOUBRAY ST. JOHN), J.P., Melchbourne Park, Sharnbrook, S.O., Bedfordshire; son of the 14th Baron; born at Melchbourne, December 4th, 1844; head of the family that came over with the Conqueror, in whose train an ancestor was "supervisor of the waggon and carriages" during the invasion of England; succeeded his brother in 1887; educated at Elstree, and by private tutors; held a Commission in the 74th Highlanders for a short time; Justice of the Peace and Lord Lieutenant for Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire; Chairman of Quarter Sessions, Bedfordshire; Chairman of North Bedfordshire Constitutional Association; a Conservative and Churchman. Married Helen Charlotte, daughter of the late Harry Thornton, Kempston Grange, Bedfordshire. Heir: son, Hon. Henry Beauchamp Oliver St. John, J.P., D.L. Club: Junior Carlton.
