Melchbourne Park, Sharnbrook, S.O., Bedfordshire; son of the 14th Baron; born at Melchbourne, December 4th, 1844; head of the family that came over with the Conqueror, in whose train an ancestor was "supervisor of the waggons and carriages" during the invasion of England; succeeded his brother in 1887; educated at Elstree, and by private tutors; held a Commission in the 74th Highlanders for a short time; Justice of the Peace and Lord Lieutenant for Bedfordshire and Herefordshire; Chairman of Quarter Sessions, Bedfordshire; Chairman of North Bedfordshire Constitutional Association; a Conservative and Churchman. Married Helen Charlotte, daughter of the late Harry Thornton, Kempston Grange, Bedfordshire. Heir: son, Hon. Henry Beauchamp Oliver St. John, J.P., D.L. Club: Junior Carlton.
