

Croquet & Tennis in the Rectory Garden c1907

View from the Rectory looking towards what is now St Mary's Close. The church tower is just visible above the treetops left of centre. The tennis courts abutted the vegetable garden, part of which is now taken up by 'The Haven'. The path to the left of the picture originally led to the door in the garden wall, providing a direct and private route to the north gate of the churchyard and, across it, the north door to the nave, now blocked on the other side by the relocated St John memorial.
